Dear Parents/Carers

I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and well?

We understand that there have been many pressures on families as a result of Covid-19. We also understand that the absence of a breakfast club at the start of September may increase these pressures. As I have outlined before, starting breakfast club a few weeks after the term starts is a precautionary measure to ensure we have got all the children back to school in a safe way before beginning this extra layer of provision. However, in light of considering the pressures on families amongst other factors, we have reviewed our start and finish times to ensure earlier start times for most year groups as well as children in KS1 classes finishing largely before KS2 to make pick-up easier and to enable the collection of children to follow the pattern it may have done prior to March 2020. Whilst to minimise adult contact we would like families to stick to these five minute windows for the first drop-off or pick-up, we understand that families dropping off and picking up siblings may not be able to stick exactly to these times for the children after the first one is dropped-off or picked-up and we will be flexible with this waiting with the children as is necessary.

The aim is for this to be organised by Fun 4 U but taking place at Wath CofE Primary School. Fun 4 U will provide more information to parents as soon as this is practically possible and once the package they can offer is fully developed.
